### Streetscape Update.

Helen has been in touch with the Shire in an effort to find out when the “DRAFT PLAN” will be available. Tim Rowe has advised that the draft should be finished by the end of April 2004, and should contain the core requirements:-

- Slow traffic down and provide safe crossing points for school children to cross the road to the Library, Tennis Courts etc.
- Enhance the visual aspect of the town
- Connect the Rail Trail to the town via a footpath and also upgrade existing footpaths

Assuming that the draft plan arrives by the end of April, there will be a Public Meeting to discuss it and formulate your ideas for a delegation to meet with Councillors before or at the May Council meeting.
